

# Hanwell Rural Community Amateur Photo Contest Rules

#### **OVERVIEW:**

- 1. <u>Categories:</u> Nature, and People/Pets. Each photograph can only be entered in one category and must be accompanied by a separate entry form.
- 2. **Two age groups:** will be allowed in each category: Youth (18 and under) and Adult (19 +).
- 3. <u>Prizes:</u> \$100 in each age group per category as well as having your photograph on display at the Hanwell community center. No person may win more than one prize. Prizes must be accepted as awarded.
- 4. **Submission Deadline:** May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019. There is no entry fee.

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

- 5. Photograph must have been taken in Hanwell, NB.
- 6. Photographs previously published in any print publication, in full or in part, will be disqualified.
- 7. Only the photographer has the right to submit a photograph. Prizes will be awarded to the photographers.
- 8. Employees and Council of Hanwell RC and prize-sponsoring companies, judges, and their immediate families, and professional photographers are not eligible.

#### **HOW TO ENTER:**

- 9. Complete an entry form and submit it along with your printed 5x7 photo to the Hanwell Municipal Office, 1757 rte. 640, Unit 5, Hanwell, NB. Forms are available online or at the office.
- 10. The photographer must obtain written consent of all individuals in the photo or their guardians if under the age of 18, and from individuals who own personal property (buildings, gardens, etc.) featured in the photograph.
- 11. By entering the contest, the photographer agrees to abide by the contest rules.



## **Photo Specifications:**

- 1. Photos may be colour or black-and-white digital photographs. Minor digital adjustments are acceptable, i.e. colour correction, cropping, etc...
- 2. Watermarks or signatures are not allowed.
- 3. Winners will be required to submit original material (high resolution files) for reproduction purposes, so winning pictures can be published.

### Where will my photo be featured?

- 1. By submitting your photo, the photographer grants to Hanwell Rural Community the right to publish the photographer's winning entry along with the photographer's name for marketing and promotional purposes. The photographer will not receive further compensation. Winners also agree that without further payment, their winning photograph entry may be used in print or electronic form to promote future photo contests. It is the responsibility of the contestant to ensure that publication of the photographs by Hanwell Rural Community raises no legal claims. The photographer must own all rights to any photographs entered in this contest.
- 2. The names of the winners, and their photographs will be published in an upcoming edition of the Hanwell Herald and on Hanwell Community events FB page. Before being awarded a prize, each winning photographer will be required to sign an agreement declaring that: (a) he or she doesn't work as a professional; (b) the photograph submitted is his or her original work; (c) the photograph was taken at the location specified on the entry form.
- 3. Winning photos will be displayed at the Hanwell Recreation Center.

**JUDGING:** Entries will be judged by the Hanwell Rural Community Mayor and Council. The decisions of the judges are final. Winners will be notified by telephone or e- mail. The winning photographs will be unveiled during Hanwell Days 2019.
