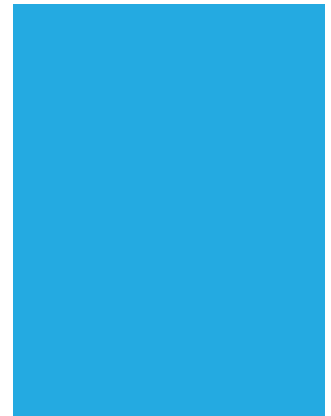

# An Investment in Wellness

## HANWELL'S NEW PHARMACY DEDICATED TO THE WELLBEING OF RESIDENTS



Hanwell is a growing community. The signs are all around: a new recreational park, a new multifunctional facility on the way, a new fire hall, and continuing discussions about the need for a local school. Another sure sign of growth is businesses setting up shop and investing in the community. In October 2018, Hanwell residents experienced this when **The Medicine Shoppe**, operated by pharmacist Natalie Barry, opened its doors, welcoming new customers.

Barry has been working as a pharmacist for more than 25 years, and has long been a pharmacy owner in Fredericton, operating the Brookside Medicine Shoppe location. Her decision to open in Hanwell reflects her belief in the future of the community. "I have always felt that Hanwell is a valuable part of our region and province," she says. "The people who live in Hanwell deserve a pharmacy that is focused on their health and wellbeing. We are proud to be part of this community, and are committed to providing exceptional services including low wait times for prescriptions, administration of vaccines, and prescribing for minor ailments. We also look forward to offering unique and beneficial health and wellness events."

For Hanwell resident Julie Mason, the value of the new pharmacy became clear on a dark, rainy November afternoon. "It's great to have this service available right here," says Mason. "I came in on my

way home from work and got exactly the advice, and medicine, I needed. Fast, friendly service, and I was able to gas my car up at the same time. The convenience can't be argued."



The pharmacy, located next to **Scholten's** on the Hanwell Road, is currently open Monday to Friday from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Barry hopes to extend business hours as soon as possible, but for now, customers can also benefit from delivery services. "Our long term goal is to open on Saturdays and later in the evening," says Barry. "In the meantime, we offer free delivery. Simply ask for delivery when you request your prescription and we will ensure it gets to you when needed. Additionally, we are able to access patient files from our Brookside Drive location, which is open Saturdays until 1 p.m. Any

prescriptions for Hanwell patients can be filled at this location and picked up or delivered on Saturdays."

In speaking with Barry, her commitment to service is evident, along with her deep sense of the role a pharmacy can play in the community. The process of launching the business took over a year, beginning with scouting locations, and the journey brought Barry into contact with numerous local people and organizations. "We're so pleased to be part of the Scholten's location, and have been fortunate to work with a wonderful group of local builders, planners, and suppliers, including Chris Scholten, Starlite Construction, and Stortec, Inc.," says Barry. "Our store may be on the small side, but the ambience is bright and welcoming, and we're offering full pharmacy services. We really want residents to know how excited we are to be here." Business has been good so far, and there was an official ribbon cutting on November 28. Barry hopes many more community members will come out to see what's available. "Business has been great so far," she says "It's been wonderful to meet new people. Our patients appreciate that we're here, and have given us a lot of positive and encouraging feedback."

## EMERGENCY MEASURES COMMITTEE

Last year the rural community of Hanwell participated in a province-wide emergency preparedness exercise, Brunswick Alpha, in conjunction with other municipalities, New Brunswick Emergency Measures Organization (NBEMO) and other participating partners. This year, NBEMO introduced Brunswick Bravo, a continuation of last year's exercise, and our dedicated and hard-working Emergency Measures Committee members are looking forward to this exercise to practice our roles and responsibilities during actual emergency events.

As a community, it is important for all of our residents to be prepared for emergencies of all shapes, sizes and strengths; "preparedness starts with you"! The three steps to emergency preparedness are:

- Know the Risks (what types of situations are we, in Hanwell, likely to be faced with? Are you ready?)
- Make a Plan (create an emergency plan for you, your family, your pets, in case of an emergency)
- Get a Kit (put together a portable bag or backpack with your essentials for 72-hour preparedness)

We urge our residents to also sign up for Sentinel Emergency Alert. It's quick and easy to register, just go to our website, click on the "Emergency Alert" button, and follow the instructions. In the event that our community experiences an emergency situation such as forest fires or road closures, an automated message will be sent to the contact information provided upon sign-up (via email, text or voice-message). Only those who register will receive these alerts.

Our Emergency Measures Committee meets once a month, is comprised of several volunteers with preparedness in mind, and have a variety of backgrounds and skillsets to implement our emergency plan. - **Terri L. Parker, Emergency Coordinator**

## AGE FRIENDLY COMMUNITY

The Age Friendly Committee continues to be very busy. We are currently working on the final steps to receive our designation as an age-friendly community (very exciting!)

We have also hosted two Open Houses for those who wanted a hand in completing the survey as well as meet the Committee members. Later this year, we plan to make available the results from the survey and prepare an Action Plan for the future.

We are working hard on facilitating programs, games and events for all ages. Our state-of-the-art Community Centre and Municipal Office will also be completely accessible for those who may be differently-abled so that everyone will be able to enjoy the space during events.

On Sunday, June 9, 2019 from 1:00 PM - 4:00 PM, the committee will be holding an Open House and Exhibit, with local exhibitors/vendors whose target audience are residents aged 50 and up. Light refreshments will also be provided. We hope to see you there.

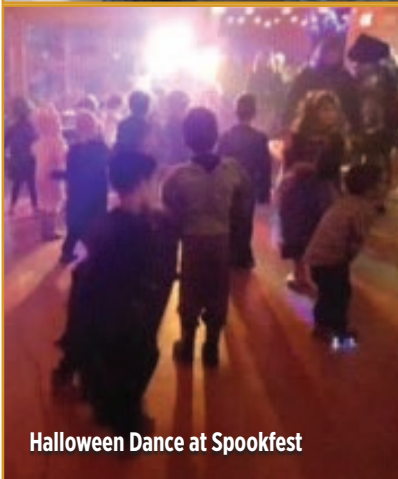
