



By-Law No. 24-2022

A By-Law To Regulate the Use of Public Parks

Within the Rural Community of Hanwell

Pursuant to subsection 10(2)(b) of the *Local Governance Act*, SNB 2017, c.18, amendments thereto and regulations adopted thereunder, the Council of the rural community of Hanwell hereby enacts as follows:

TITLE

This By-Law may be referred to as the "Park By-Law".

DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of this By-Law:

"Clerk" means the clerk of the Rural Community of Hanwell.

"Department Head" means an employee of the Rural Community of Hanwell designated as a Department Head.

"Hanwell" means the Rural Community of Hanwell.

"Motor Vehicle" means every vehicle that is self-propelled, including trucks, cars, motorcycles, mopeds, go-carts, minibikes, all-terrain vehicles and snowmobiles (other than for grooming trails).

"Park" means any of the lands and premises within Hanwell designated for recreational and public use and, for greater certainty, includes playgrounds and the parks listed in Schedule "A" attached hereto.

"Hanwell Staff" means the Clerk and/or members of staff of the Rural Community of Hanwell, that report to the Clerk.

GENERAL

No person shall drive, ride or park a motor vehicle, snowmobile, or horse in or upon a park within Hanwell, except on such roadways and/or areas as designated for their use.

No person shall, without first obtaining approval in writing from the Clerk:

- a) Light a fire within a park
- b) Use a park, or any portion thereof, for the purposes of holding or carrying on a fair carnival, bazaar, show, circus or operate a canteen outlet.
- c) Pitch a tent, park a trailer or recreational vehicle in a park.
- d) Loiter or remain in a park between sunset and one hour before sunrise of the following day, except when walking or hiking.
- e) Hold any public gatherings or meetings within a park without obtaining permission from the Clerk.
- f) No person shall tamper with or injure any flowers, or any flower bed, vegetation, or any tree or shrub growing or being on a park, or any kiosk, bench, or other article, or thing therein or thereon, or shall damage, injure, or foul any park or any part hereof in any manner whatsoever.
- g) No person shall leave, throw, drop or deposit, or permit to be deposited any bottle, glass, rubbish, refuse, wastepaper, waste or trash of any kind in a park except into containers specifically provided for that purpose.
- h) No person shall permit a dog to run loose in a park except for designated areas; dogs must be secured on a leash and any excrement from a dog must be cleaned up immediately by the owner or the person having control of the dog.

ENFORCEMENT

Any person who violates any provision of this By-Law and is guilty of an offence will be provided a warning or a fine for the first offence issued by Hanwell staff or an authorized By-law enforcement officer under the Policy, #2022-05 Rural Community of Hanwell Fee Schedule.
