

Summer Employment

Position: Parks Maintenance Labourer

Term: May 6 - August 23, 2024

Hours: 37.5 hours per week; some flexibility required

Description:

The Parks Maintenance Labourer will work with the staff of the Rural Community of Hanwell to assist in the maintenance of parks, trails, and all other green spaces throughout the community. They are to maintain the trail networks to ensure they are operating in a safe and desirable condition, which may involve digging, raking, shoveling, and hauling fill, etc. The Park Maintenance Labourer will also assist in the maintenance of flowers and shrubs, light landscaping such as grass trimming, staining, painting various structures within our parks. The Parks Maintenance Labourers will report to the Director of Recreation & Parks. The Parks Maintenance Labourer must be familiar with using basic tools, working outside in various weather conditions, and be able to receive instructions in a professional manner.

Must have:

- Valid Drivers' License (required to operate UTV)
- O Student must agree to wear protective eye/ear gear when operating or nearby equipment, such as: Generator, chainsaw, brush cutter, skill saw,etc.
- Student must have steel-toed work boots
- Knowledge of basic carpentry tool usage is an asset

To be eligible, all applicants:

- Must be a team player
- O Must be a resident of New Brunswick
- O Must be eligible to work in Canada
- O For SEED, applicants must also:
 - Be a student who was registered full-time during the preceding academic year
 - o Intend to return to school on a full-time basis during the next academic year
- O For Canada Summer Jobs, applicants must also:
 - O Be between the ages of 15 and 30
