Community Reminder: Solid Waste Collection & Disposal Information

As written in By-Law No. 07-2015, and amended February 23rd, 2021, garbage will only be picked up if it is bagged. Bags must be securely tied to avoid garbage becoming loose.

For the collection and disposal of larger items exceeding 44 lbs., residents must contact BMI (506-209-0669) prior to placing these items at the side of the road. Residents are permitted to one collection of larger items per month, and a total of 9 collections per year.

Garbage is collected between the hours of 7:00 am and 7:00 pm. Residents must have garbage at the side of the road by 7:00 am.
