This is a reminder of the incoming weather event that will be happening over the next couple of days.

Due to the heavy rain, 25-50mm, and the plus 10-degree temperatures causing rapid snowmelt, there most likely will be localized flooding. We will also be getting strong southerly winds, 70-90 kms later today and into tomorrow, which could cause falling trees on roads and power lines.

Please take this time to get prepared for possible power outages, ensure that any loose items in your yard or deck are secure, and remove any excess snow from doorways etc., to prevent leakage into your homes.

If you don't have a 72-hour kit in place, we strongly recommend that you get prepared this morning. A copy of a list of items is attached.
